**Subject:** **Evaluated data library coded under MONIT-REF**

There are variations in coding of evaluated data libraries under the keyword MONIT-REF. To keep consistency, the following update of the Formats manual is proposed

**MONIT-REF:** Gives information about the source reference for the standard (or monitor) data used in the experiment.

2. The code contains 3 main fields which may be preceded by a heading field:

((heading)subaccession#,author,reference)

...

**Reference Field.** Must be present. May contain up to 6 subfields, coded exactly as under REFERENCE *except for evaluated data library (Type of Reference = 3), for which the two following general coding forms are allowed:*

(...,3,code-version,,date)  
(...,3,code-version,MAT-number,date)

*If the code-version is not known, provide the information in free text under the keyword MONITOR. Format manuals (e.g. ENDF-102 for the ENDF format manual) may not be coded under this keyword. Summary reports (e.g. ENDF-201 for the ENDF/B-VI library) may be coded with reference type R when the exact code-version information (e.g. ENDF/B-VI.8) is not available.*

**Code-version subfield:** Must be present. A code from Dictionary 144 (Data Libraries). *The version may have any content (except commas) but should comply with official library numbering (see examples in Dictionary 144). In general, one should use a Roman numeral for versions of the ENDF/B library and Arabic numerals for other libraries and for the release number (e.g. ENDF/B-VI.8, JEFF-3.1, JENDL-3.3, etc.).*

**MAT-number sub field:** May be omitted, but the following comma is always included.

**Date subfield:** Must be present. Date is taken from Dictionary 144 (Data Libraries) if it is not given by authors.
